This Autumn 2024 Beginners watch session is for a 12 week course. Existing members have preference on places up to 6 September 2024 after which applications from new members will be accepted. Applications are not complete until remittance is received. The session will be based around a common basic Swiss lever movement and will include choice of, and maintenance of tools and equipment, cleaning and lubrication, and assembly of the project watch. A basic toolkit will be available for you to use on the first week or two but it is expected that you will buy your own basic tools once the course is underway. PLEASE do not buy any tools until after the first session, as you will know all things watch related can be very expensive and we are committed to keeping the costs down for you as much as we can. At the end of the course you will have your own watch that you have stripped and rebuilt to take away and wear with pride.

The fees for the course are listed below. The 'joining fee' is for EFHC to cover administrative costs and also to make you a 'member' of EFHC. This is a requirement for us to make sure that you are covered by our insurance whilst on the premises. It also gives you access to all EFHC facilities including the library.

It is likely that this course will be very popular and so it is recommended that your application and remittance are returned quickly. Places are limited and applications will be dealt with on a first come first served basis. Further details regarding location etc, will be provided to successful applicants.
